Maltimur Leads Delegation To Kalimantan Barat

Tuesday, 8 November 2022, Kuching - Maltimur was part of a delegation of Sarawak private sector companies that journeyed to Kalimantan Barat (Kalbar) between 1 to 4 November 2022 for project development. With the move of the Indonesian capital from Jakarta to Nusantara in Kalimantan, the prospect for new business opportunities are many and varied. A trip to see, engage and understand the business scene was important.

Apart from Maltimur, the private sector delegation comprised businesses such as information technology, utilities and infrastructure. Maltimur's team was led by Executive Chairman, Ir. Haji Junaidi Sahadan. The purpose of the visit was to establish networks with local key stakeholders and explore prospective projects.

The delegates also had a unique opportunity to visit the newly completed Port Tanjungpura, formerly known as Port Kijing. The port is Kalimantan's deep seaport and hub for exporting goods, which is central to Indonesia's economy.
