Maltimur Conducts Recce Ahead of Project

Monday, 24 October 2022, Kuching – Maltimur recently conducted a recce at Limbang and surrounding localities such as Nanga Medamit, and Kuala Medalam, as preparation for the proposed Sabah-Sarawak Link Road Phase 2 (SSLR 2).

Leading the trip was Haji Azrin Ahmad (SSLR 2 Project Director) and joined by Ir. Abdul Wahid Daud (Design Manager), Justin Sabastian Kulai (Stakeholder Management, Coordinator), and representatives from Aktif Unggul and KTA.

The purpose of the trip was to survey suitable sites for a project management office, and study the demographic, soil condition, and existing infrastructures. Findings gathered from this trip will enable Maltimur to have a solid start for when development for SSLR 2 takes off.

Apart from studying the terrain and existing structures, the team also engaged key stakeholders such as Tuai Rumah Thaddeus Aling and Pemanca Robert Kunya. These engagement provided a glimpse into the perspective of the locals which will prove crucial in managing the initiation and progression of projects within the region.

SSLR 2 is a continuation of SSLR Phase 1 which stretches from Simpang Selugus to Long Lopeng. Phase 2, which covers a distance of 326km, will connect Miri to Limbang and Lawas without crossing Brunei by linking Mulu to Long Merarap.
